The Falcons Futbol Club is a competitive club formed to develop top quality players. We attract the best young players from all over the Memphis metropolitan area. We have an unwavering commitment to player development. We feel that the youngest ages are vital in the soccer player's development.

We work with our players to establish a strong foundation consisting of the basic fundamental skills required to play and enjoy the game. We instill a winning mentality in our players by building confidence through technical and tactical ability and mental toughness.

At the core of a good soccer club is a top quality coaching staff. We are happy to present the best coaching staff in the business. Our coaches are passionate about soccer and teaching the game to young players. The most important part of what we do is to develop solid, balanced young men and women through soccer.

The FalconsFC teams play competitive soccer in the Memphis Shelby Soccer Federation (MSSF) league in Memphis. All teams play their league games at the Mike Rose soccer Complex. In addition to league play, our teams participate in State and Club-run tournaments.

Typically our teams practice twice a week. This schedule includes skills on Saturday morning and a team practice on a weeknight. Practices are held at:

Teams will play 10 – 12 league games in the Fall Season and another 10-12 league games in the Spring Season. The fall season begins early September thru middle of December. The spring season begins late February and ends middle of May. League games are played on weeknights (Mon. – Thurs.) at the Mike Rose soccer complex located on Forest Hill Irene and the Bill Morris Parkway (Hwy 386).

Discounts:

We offer a sibling discount of \$100 off club fees per year for U9-14
\$50 sibling discount for U14 up
Managers will also receive a discount for club fees

All players have club fees (paid yearly) and team fees (paid per season)

Club Fees (paid per year)

Club Fees include the following:

- State and club player registration
- Coaching Fees
- Administrative fees
- Weekly skills sessions
- Field use fees

Club fees are non-refundable

Team Fees (paid per season)

Each player will have team expenses which include, but are not limited to:

- league fees
- referee fees
- tournament entry fees (including state tournaments)
- coach's travel expenses

Team fees are paid to the player's team. The exact amount for team fees vary widely and are based on number of players on each team, what tournaments they participate in, how many tournaments they participate in and the cost and location of tournament. All team fees are due before the season starts.

Fundraising:

Every team will be offered the opportunity to do a fundraiser each season to raise money for their team fees. Fundraising packages will be handed out by mid July for teams interested.

Uniforms Fees:

Uniforms are purchased every two years (or on an as-needed basis) and are additional.

Uniform Kit includes

- 2 -Jersey's
- 2 -Shorts
- 2- training T-shirt
- 2-Socks

Uniform fees are approximately \$140 per kit. Bags and warm-ups are optional, but may be purchased at the same time as the uniforms. (Includes all embroidery and numbers). We are now being sponsored by Puma and therefore everyone in the club will be switching to Puma uniforms for the 2009/2010 season

Financial Assistance:

All of these figures (amounts) are based on a combination of past expenses and are subject to change. Financial Assistance is available for club fees to families experiencing hardships. Application for assistance must be submitted to playsoccer@falconsfutbol.com. Approval is on a case by case basis. Scholarships are limited and only apply to club fees.
